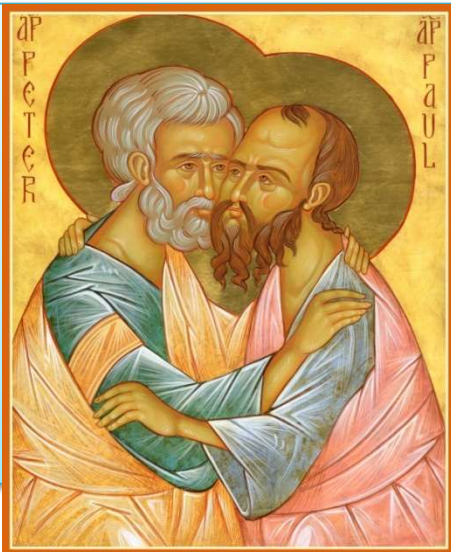

WE WELCOME YOU TODAY

We would like to remind our visitors of the following;:

- ❖ All people are encouraged to participate in the sacred services of our Church. We hope that you will be able to worship as well as have fellowship with us. Should you wish any information about the Orthodox Faith or this parish in particular, please see the rector or any member of the church. We are able to place you on our mailing list.
- ❖ Only Orthodox Christians may receive the Eucharist (Holy Communion) in the Orthodox Church. In like manner, Orthodox Christians may not receive the sacraments in a non-Orthodox Church. While we hope that one day all Christians will find unity and be able to approach the chalice of our Lord together, we observe the teachings of the Church that the Eucharist is a gift of unity and not a means of unity.

We remind our faithful and visitors of the following guidelines concerning the Holy Sacraments in the Orthodox Church.

- ❖ Orthodox Christians are urged to receive Holy Communion frequently.
- ❖ Communicants should be at peace with others before approaching the chalice (Mt 5:23-24)
- ❖ Realize the importance of making a thorough examination of sins and transgressions against God, ourselves and others and having prayed for forgiveness before coming to Holy Communion.
- ❖ Frequent communicants should come to Holy Confession at least four times a year (during the four fasting periods of the year) and additionally when an examination of conscience reveals the necessity to do so in order to heal any sinful behavior.
- ❖ Communicants should fast from all foods and liquids from the evening before receiving Holy Communion.
- ❖ Communicants should read prayers in preparation for receiving Holy Communion.
- ❖ All Orthodox Christians must receive the sacraments at least once a year.
- ❖ Those who are late for Divine Liturgy (after the reading of the Epistle and Gospel) should not approach the chalice.
- ❖ Those who are ill or who have special physical needs are exempt from the above guidelines.
- ❖ Infants and children (up to the age of seven) who are Orthodox Christians may receive Holy Communion and are exempt from the above guidelines.

Thank you for gathering to worship with us today. Together we have glorified the One God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. May we be brought closer to one another and closer to God by following the eternal teachings of our Lord.

Нагадуємо нашім гостям., що:

ми заохочуємо всіх до участі у Священній Літургії в нашій Церкві; ми сподіваємося, що Ви зможете не лише молитися тут, але й стати членом нашої громади. Плекаючи надію на те, що у майбутньому всі християни досягнуть єдності і зможуть разом пити із чаші нашого Господа, ми дотримуємося вчення церкви про те, що Євхаристія - це дар єдності, а не засіб до єдності.

НАГАДУЄМО НАШИМ ВІРНИМ І ГОСТЯМ ПРО ПРАВИЛА, ЩО СТОСУЮТЬСЯ СВЯТОГО ПРИЧАСТЯ У ПРАВОСЛАВНІЙ ЦЕРКВІ:

ми спонукаємо православних християн часто ходити до Святого Причастя;

ті, хто причащається, повинні бути у мирі з іншими перш, нас підійти до євхаристичної чаші (Св.Матвії 5:23-24);

перед тим, як прийти на Святе Причастя, дуже важливо ретельно осмислити гріхи і порушення, які було вчинено проти Бога, нас самих та інших і помолитися за їх відпущення;

тим, хто часто причащається, слід приходити на святую сповідь принаймні чотири рази на рік (під час кожного із чотирьох щорічних постів);

ті, хто причащається, повинні з вечора перед прийняттям Святого Причастя, припинити вживання всякої їжі і напоїв;

ті, хто причащається, повинні шляхом молитов підготувати себе до прийняття причастя;

всі православні християни повинні, принаймні, раз на рік отримати Святе Причастя;

ті, хто спізнився на Божественну Літургію (прийшов після того, як було прочитано Апостол і Євангеліє) не можуть підходити до чаші; **хворі**, і ті, хто має обмежені фізичні можливості, звільняються від вище викладених вимог;

немовлята та діти до семи років, які належать до Православної християнської віри, можуть отримувати Святе Причастя і звільняються від вище викладених вимог;

Дякуємо за те, що Ви прийшли помолитися з нами сьогодні у церкві Ісуса Христа. Разом з вами ми віддали славу Єдиному Господу, Отцеві, і Синові, і Духові Святому. Нехай дотримання вічного вчення нашого Господа наблизить нас один до одного Богу

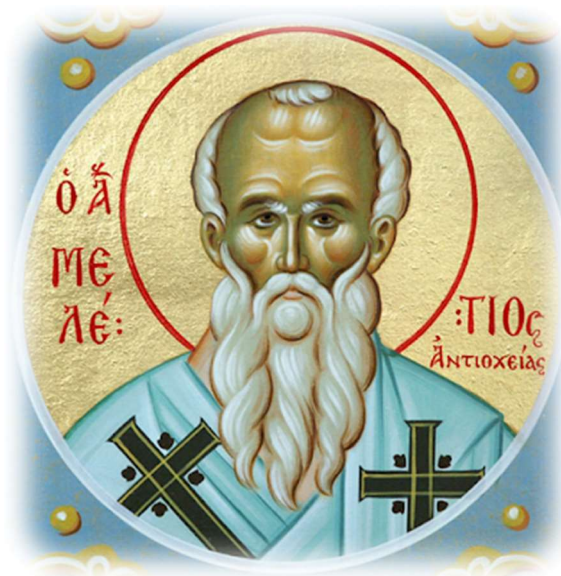

LESSON FROM THE SECOND EPISTLE OF SAINT PAUL TO TIMOTHY (c. 3, v. 10-15)

Timothy, my child, you have followed my teaching, my guidance, my purpose, my faith, my endurance, my love, my patience, my persecutions, and my sufferings. You know what happened to me in Antioch, in Iconium, in Lystra, and what persecutions I underwent in these cities. But the Lord rescued me from all of them.

Indeed, all those, who want to live piously in Jesus Christ, will be persecuted, while wicked men and impostors will go on from bad to worse, deceiving others and deceiving themselves. But you must hold fast to the doctrines you have been taught and have firmly believed. You know who taught them to you. Moreover, from childhood you have been acquainted with the Holy Scriptures, which show you the way to salvation through faith in Jesus Christ.

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Sponsor-A-Day Program Update

At the annual parish meeting held in October 2023 the parish voted to approve the Finance Committee's recommendation to implement a Sponsorship program to raise money for the church's General Fund. The General Fund is used to pay the day-to-day operating expenses of the church and church properties (Ex: utilities, insurance, salaries, etc.).

Our 10/2022-9/2023 General Fund expenses were approximately \$150,000 (10/21-9/22 was more, at approximately \$162,500) and our 2024 member obligations are \$725 per member. With about 100 members (our current membership), member obligations will cover about \$72,500 of expenses (less than half of our expected annual expenses). Historically, the gap between member obligations and expenses has been covered largely by the generous donations of our church organizations, parishioners, and friends. But, with so many (38) of our members passing away over the last 5 years, the gap is greater than ever.

The Sponsor-A-Day program is a way to contribute to the church's financial well-being beyond obligations. It costs approximately \$450 per day to operate the church, hall, and rectory. **If you are able and interested in sponsoring a day of operating expenses (or a half day or any portion of a day), please complete the form on the back of the bulletin and provide it, along with your donation, to Treasurer Brittany Brettell.**

Please note that this program is intended to be a supplement to member obligations. So, we only encourage participation if you are able to donate beyond your 2024 member obligations.

In the past we have had people not do so.*

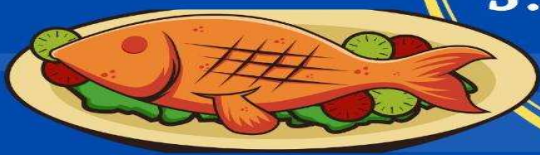

They Who Surround Us

A film by Troy Ruptash



Hello, I'm a Ukrainian/Canadian filmmaker living in Los Angeles. I recently completed my first feature, **THEY WHO SURROUND US**, inspired by my journey researching my Ukrainian family history. I wrote and directed the film.

My grandmother fled Ukraine in the early 1930s after her parents were killed by the Red Army. She resettled in Vegreville, Alberta where I grew up. Her brother, my great uncle, remained in Ukraine and we had always been told that he had died in a prison camp in Siberia. I had the opportunity to travel to Ukraine in 2019 to work with a genealogist and research my family's history. While there, we discovered that my great uncle had gotten out of Siberia, became a commander with UPA (the Ukrainian Partisan Army), fighting for Ukraine's independence.

The film is inspired by their story and deals with generational trauma and the struggle of those who must flee their homes during a war and rebuild their lives in another country.

Sadly the film is all too relevant as we see history repeating itself again in Ukraine.

I'm excited to announce that the film was picked up by The Film Arcade for streaming distribution in the U.S. and the U.K starting February 23rd.

It will be available on **Apple TV, Amazon and Google Play.**

The success I have had thus far with the film in Canada is largely due to the support I've received at a grass roots level from the Ukrainian community. We are starting a similar outreach program in the US and UK to raise awareness about the film, which is why I am reaching out to you!
